Seven Referees Clinics were conducted in Amman, Macau, Jakarta, Hong Kong (2), Tehran and Colombo. And eight Referees Assessment Exercises were conducted during a number of tournaments including the PSA Championships in Amman (October), East Asian Games in Tianjin (October), Macau Open (October), China Open in Shanghai (October), the National Championship in Jakarta (November), Hong Kong Open (December), the National Championship in Colombo (December) and in Tehran (February 2014).

Besides, I had also conducted a Regional Assessors Programme in Hong Kong on 30 November 2013 just before the Hong Kong Open started.

On 4 to 5 October 2013, Jordan hosted the World Referees Conference in Amman, where a total of 30 participants from some 10 countries took part in this event.

I would like to thank all instructors and assessors who travelled around to help the success of all these events.
