## **CHAMPIONSHIP INFORMATION**

- The DJO is an ASF Junior Super Series Silver event organized by Qatar Squash Federation. All participants will receive ASF ranking points (all categories). Details can be seen at <u>http://www.asiansquash.org/</u>
- 2. <u>Tournament Director</u>: Alaaeldeen Allouba
- 3. <u>Venue</u>: Khalifa International Tennis & Squash Complex, Doha, Qatar. 8 ASB glass back courts plus one Courtwall glass court.
- 4. <u>Age Categories</u>: There will be 10 categories Boys & Girls under 11, 13, 15, 17 & 19. A player can enter in only one age category.
- 5. Age Cut-off Date: March 9, 2016
- <u>Eligibility</u>: The tournament is open to all juniors of any nationality. All foreign player entries <u>must</u> be endorsed by their respective National Association. Non endorsed entry forms by the National Association will not be accepted

#### 8. Scoring & Format:

- All matches will be played to the best of five games, 11 points PAR (Point-A-Rally). WSF Rules of the World Singles Game will be applied throughout the tournament.
- The format of each draw will be decided by QSF depending on the number of entries.
- Players are expected to play two matches a day.
- The first round of each draw will start on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> March in the afternoon. The following day (Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup>) two rounds will be played per day. The same pattern of play will follow on Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup>. Subject to the size of each draw the final will be played either on Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> in the morning or early afternoon.

### 9. Protective Eye Wear:

Wearing of Protective Eye Wear is Mandatory.

#### 10. Foreign Currency Exchange:

The currency of Qatar is Qatar Riyal (QR), the approximate prevailing rate is USD 1.00 = QR 3.63.
