This year the Asian region had organized two WSF events World Junior Individual & Team Championship at Chennai India & Women's World Team Championship at Dalian China. The Asian Games also held at Jakarta Indonesia.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> focal points meeting was held on 24<sup>th</sup> March 2018 at Cheongju Korea prior to ASF AGM. - Develop the standard refereeing syllabus manual for clinic/course/workshop to be conducted throughout Asia.
- Organize Asian Refereeing conference.
- Create more opportunities for Regional Referees.
- Revisit nomination criteria for Regional Assessor.

## **Referees Clinic**
