

# Standard Features in Conducting Referees Clinics &

## Assessment Exercises in Asia

---

### Objectives

- To support the development of referees in Asia through a comprehensive programme of Referees Clinics conducted at the appropriate levels of competence and carrying out Assessment Exercises in conjunction with major championships.
- To ensure that ASF contributes to the development of referees at the Introductory, National, Regional and World standards.

### Duration

- **Referees clinics:** varying from a minimum of 2 days to 7 days, depending on the level of knowledge/competence of the participants and special requirements of each country.
- **Assessment exercises:** varying between 3 to 7 days, depending on the duration of the championships.

### Costs of Host Federation

- Payment for ASF Clinic Tutor or Assessor for travel via most direct route (including ancillary costs such as personal travel / medical insurance, visa fees, any vaccination / medication costs considered necessary for travel to the host country)
- Accommodation (single room) at a 4-star hotel.
- All 3 meals per day or USD40.00 per day if meals are not provided, including the day before and the day after the event.
- All transport within the host country as required.
- Consultation fee of USD150.00 per day for Clinic Tutor or Assessor, including the day before and the day after the event.
- Any other relevant incidental expenses.
