© Age Group Events

Open (U19, U17, U15, U13, U11) boys and girls. Players may only enter one age category, either in the appropriate age category or in a higher age category, if so desired.

*There will be a plate competition in each category.

(In principle, two matches per player are guaranteed. *including Bye)

Note: If there are less than 8 players in each category, the event will be held jointly with the category above age.

(Under the rules of the WSF and ASF, matches with less than 8 players are **unauthorized**.)

However, if there are less than 8 participants in U19, the WSF and ASF will hold the event as a non-sanctioned event.

*If a competitor abandons during the main competition or any plate competition, he/she will be disqualified and **will not receive** any AJSS or WJ ranking points.

The first day of the tournament will be for the U11, 13 and 15 categories.

The main draw will also be at this venue from day 2 onwards.

All semi-finals and finals will be at this venue.

© **Events and Eligibility**

The Japan Junior Open is open to all players under the ages of 11, 13, 15, 17 and 19.

Categories are determined according to age as of 13 August 2024 (last day of the competition).

A player can participate in only one event in or higher his/her age category.

All players (including team officials) entries must be endorsed by their respective National Association/Federation.

IMPORTANT : All players who will play **U19 & U17** are required to have a valid SPIN registration number in order to enter.

Please note that SPIN number has to be renewed every year if your first registration was in 2018 or later

© Practice Court

© Transportation

The nearest airports are Narita International Airport and Tokyo International Airport.

Please note that JSA is **not** providing pick-up at the Airport

You will find English speaking assistance at the information desk in the airports, at the station, and at the hotel.

© Accommodations

No official Hotels are arranged. Please book by yourself.

The recommended areas are around Shin-Yokohama Station and Yokohama Station, but hotels are quite crowded due to summer holidays in Japan.

In addition, although the number of hotels is small, it is thought that it will be easy to move between the two venues if you take a hotel along the Sotetsu Line.

© Matches

All matches in main draw will be the best of five games, 11 point-PAR and will follow the World Squash Singles Rules. Plate matches are best of three games. Seeding will be carried out by JSA in accordance with the term of ASF Championship Regulations.

© Player Withdrawal

Withdrawal from the tournament must be notified to Japan Squash Association as soon as possible by email with a valid reason.

Please understand that entry fees cannot be refunded in the event of a withdrawal after the closing.

Late Withdrawal

Withdrawal after the closing date will be considered 'late withdrawal'. All late withdrawals must be accompanied with a medical certificate or with relevant documents supporting valid reasons. Failure to do either will result in the player scoring '**zero ranking points**'. The 'zero' ranking points will be reflected as one of the player's 4 best results. For those who produce the relevant documents, ASF will evaluate each withdrawal on a case-to-case basis.

© Referees

Both players who have finished their match should referee and marker the match after their own match (from the semi-finals onwards, JSA will make arrangements).

© Eyewear

Junior players under the age of 19 are required to wear protective spectacles; they must be of the model applied for by the WSF and must be worn correctly over the eyes at all times during matches and practice.

© Official Ball

The Dunlop Pro XX (double yellow dot) ball will be the official ball for the championship.

© Code Of Conduct

All competitors denote their agreement to abide by the Japan Squash Association Code of Conduct and the WSF Junior Guidelines by entering the tournament.

© Anti-Doping

All players are required to acknowledge the WSF's Anti-Doping Rules and Regulations and the Doping rules set out in Regulations E12 - E15 of the ASF Championship Regulations prior to competing in the Championships as part of the accreditation process. Any players refusing to undergo a doping control and any player found guilty of a doping infraction proven by a positive laboratory test result will be dealt with by the ASF, which shall take disciplinary actions and penalties in

accordance with its regulations.
