Locations and Additional Info

Championship Venue

All matches will be played at the Squash Center, 197 Vajiravudh College, Dusit, Bangkok. There are four (4) singles courts.

If the number of players is high, an additional venue option will be used at the Rama Garden Hotel, equipped with two (2) singles courts.

Entry Fees

The Entry Fee of US\$350.00 per player/official covers six (6) nights (check-in on 8th May 2025, checkout on 14th May 2025, 12:00 noon), accommodation with breakfast inclusive on a TWIN-SHARING basis. Each boys' and girls' team shall only redeem for their officials a maximum of two (2) rooms with the rates stated above, respectively. The team shall pay the room rate difference for any SINGLE occupancy.

For SINGLE OCCUPANCY, the Entry Fee is US\$680.00 per player/official and covers six (6) nights (check-in on 8th May 2025, check-out on 14th May 2025, 12:00 noon) with breakfast inclusive. The provision of single rooms is subject to prior request and availability.

The entry fee WITHOUT the accommodation package is US\$120.00 per player or official.

For additional room nights, a special rate of US\$95.00 per single/twin room per night with breakfast inclusive will be offered. Booking MUST be made through the Organizer and is subject to room availability. This special room rate is also available for officials or supporters of the participating MNAs.

Entry fees must be paid no later than 15 April 2025. (or to be paid in cash immediately following the Team Managers' Meeting under the National Association's guarantee)

All bank charges for the telegraphic transfer at both ends (remitting and receiving banks) are to be borne by the participating MNFs.

All players and officials are responsible for all extra costs incurred at the hotel and venues other than the breakfasts provided by the hotel on specified dates.

All players must settle the bills for all their expenses in the room at the hotel reception before departure.

SEASF Seeding Committee

The SEASF Seeding Committee shall be responsible for the seeding of individuals. They will produce the FINAL individual seeding no later than 23 April 2025. The decision of the SEASF Seeding Committee shall be final.

For details on Seeding and Draw, please refer to M8 of the ASF Championship Regulations.

The draws will be made and announced on or before 3rd May 2025.

Championship Regulations

The Championship will be run in accordance with the ASF Championship regulations.

Clothing Regulations

ASF Clothing Regulation shall apply.

Dope Testing

Dope testing may be carried out in accordance with the WADA Code. All players are required to complete and sign the Doping Declaration (see attached), acknowledging the WSF's Anti-Doping Rules and Regulations and the Doping rules set out in Regulations E12 - E15 of the ASF Championship Regulations before competing in the Championships as part of the accreditation process.

Any player refusing to undergo doping control and any player found guilty of a doping infraction proven by a positive laboratory test result will be dealt with by the ASF, which shall take disciplinary actions and penalties following its regulations.

Eligibility - Important!

All juniors participating in the Championships must be under 19 years of age as at **13 May 2025**. All managers are required to present the passports of their players to the SEASF Technical Delegate to confirm eligibility before being permitted to compete. This has to be done by the Technical Delegate at the Championship Office at the Main Venue or the Official Hotel.

All players, coaches, and designated team officials must be WSF registered (SPIN), and their registration must be in good standing at the time of entry and then at the time of actual participation. Players, coaches, and designated team officials are required to provide their

WSF SPIN Number on the Biography Form (Form B), which should be submitted on 9 April 2025.

Eyewear

In accordance with Regulation G5 of the ASF Championship Regulations, all junior players (under 19 years of age) are required to wear protective eyewear (manufactured to an approved national safety standard) properly over the eyes at all times during practice and match play throughout the Championships. All junior players are required to sign the Eyewear Declaration (see attached), acknowledging acceptance and compliance with this requirement before competing in the Championships.

Format of the Championship

Entries

Each MNA shall be allowed **AN INITIAL MAXIMUM OF (5) FIVE PLAYERS** in each category. If there are slots available after the closing date, MNAs shall be allowed to enter additional players, which will be allocated as follows:

- a. First on merit to players ranked in the PSA/ASF as per rankings published on or before the Closing Date.
- b. To higher-ranked players as determined by the SEASF Seeding Committee.
- c. If there are more than 24 entries, players will be placed on a reserve list and can be called upon to play if slots become available due to withdrawals.

If there are still slots available, the Host Association may enter a maximum of four (4) additional players.

The Championships are open to all Southeast Asian juniors, provided that the player has not been banned by the Southeast Asian Squash Federation. Each player can enter only ONE (1) division in his/her age category or a higher age category if so desired.

All matches will be played to the best of five (5) games, 11 points – PAR (Point-A-Rally). WSF Rules of the World Singles Game will be applied throughout the tournament. All players are guaranteed A MINIMUM OF TWO (2) MATCHES. Players will be expected to play two (2) matches a day.

Main Draw

There shall be no play-off for the 3rd position. (3rd place medal or trophy will be presented to both losing semi-finalists of the Main Draw.)

Plate Events

There shall be a championship plate event for first-round losers. Any other plates will be announced once the entries are closed. There shall be no play-off for the 3rd position or any other position.

Functions

Prize Presentation

The official prize presentation ceremonies will take place following the completion of the Finals on 13 May 2025. All participants & prize winners are expected to be at the venue in their official team uniforms/tracksuits.

Closing Dinner

All participants are invited to the Closing Dinner at 19:30 on May 13, 2025. The venue will be confirmed at a later time.

Indemnity & Insurance

All participating associations and their delegated competitors/officials SHOULD agree to indemnify and hold **Thailand Squash Rackets Association** and **Southeast Asian Squash Federation** free from any liability and accountability for and against any claims of personal injury, death, or property damage, arising out of or in any way resulting from the participation in the said championship.

Medical

First-aiders will be present on-site throughout all sessions of play. In the case of medical emergencies and/or accidents, please report to the Championship Office for assistance and necessary action.

News & Communication

Information Boards

Information Boards will be located at the venue. Participants should refer to the Information Board regularly for news updates.

Electronic Communications

For swift communication and information dissemination between the Championship Director and the Team Managers, electronic communication channels such as email and WhatsApp groups will be utilized. Kindly furnish the email address and mobile contact number of your Team Manager in Form C.

Tin Height

In accordance with WSF and ASF practice for World and Asian Championships, the tin height for all junior championships shall be 19 inches.

Official Ball

The Dunlop Revelation Pro XX (double yellow dot black ball & yellow dot white ball) ball will be used for the championships.

Personal Belongings

Players have to look after their belongings. Please do not leave bags lying anywhere else in the venue. No responsibility can be taken for lost bags.

Players on Court

It is the responsibility of each player/team to be ready to play at the designated start time of the match.

Practice Courts

Practice courts are free of charge and will be available for all players and teams starting 8th May 2025 from 9:00 to 20:00 hours. For reservation of practice courts, please contact the Championship Office via Email: thailandsquash.intl@gmail.com

Practice courts from 9th – 13th May 2025 can be booked at the Championship Office, and booking details will be announced at the Team Managers' Meeting.

Racket Stringing

Rackets can be re-strung at the venue by a private contractor. The price for the service will be announced during the manager's meeting.

Team Managers' Meeting

There will be a Team Managers' meeting at 17:00 hours on 8 May 2025. The date and time of any subsequent meetings will be announced at the first meeting.

Team Management

Upon arrival at the Championships, Team Managers will be the official and sole representative of their Team in all matters, and at all times; the Team Manager shall act for all members of their team in receiving and giving instructions.

Costs Incurred

All players and officials will be responsible for all extras incurred at the hotel and venues other than breakfast, which will be provided on specified dates.

Championship Shirts

All participants will receive a tournament T-shirt.

Transport

During the championships, there will be regular transport provided between the hotel and the venue from 8 May 2024 till 13 May 2024. The daily transport schedule will be posted on notice boards at both the Hotel and the Venue.
