I. Championship Status & Details

- Event Name: Macau Junior Squash Open 2025
- Championship Status: AJSS "Silver" Event
- ASF Ranking Points: All participants will receive ASF junior ranking points.
- WSF Ranking Points: Players in U19 category and below will receive WSF ranking points.

II. Event Dates

Dates: 28th – 31st August 2025 (Thursday to Sunday), 27th August will be designated as the official practice day

III. Age Categories & Participation


- Categories: Boys and Girls U19, U17, U15, U13, U11
- Participation Rules:
 - Players may only enter one age category, either in their appropriate age category or a higher one if desired.
 - o All players are required to play all scheduled matches to gain points.
 - If an age category has fewer than 8 players, it will be cancelled, and players may opt to play in a higher age category.
 - All foreign player(s) entries must be endorsed by their respective National Association or Federation
 - Please note that all players must submit their correct date of birth as passport verification may be performed.

IV. Age Cut-off Date

- Eligibility: Age cut-off date is 31st August 2025.
- WSF SPIN Number: Please be advised that ALL players competing in ALL AGE GROUPS for this event WILL BE REQUIRED TO HAVE a WSF SPIN registration number which can be obtained at: http://www.worldsquash.org/spin. There is a payment required.

VI. Entry Fees & Payment Methods

- Entry Fee: USD\$80 (Foreign Players) / MOP 300 (Local Players)
 - Only those holding a Macau SAR Passport or a valid Macau Resident Identity Card will be considered as local players and will be entitled to the local entry fee.

VIII. Players Withdrawal Policy

- **Notification**: Withdrawal from the tournament must be notified to Macau Squash Association as soon as possible by Fax or email with a valid reason.
- Refund Policy: Entry fees will not be refunded if withdrawal is made after the closing date.
- Transfer Policy: Paid-up entry fees are not transferable from one player to another.

IX. Scoring & Format

- **Scoring**: All matches will be the best of five games, 11 points-PAR, following WSF Rules of World Singles Games.
- Format: Circuit or Swiss format will be used; final decision by Macau Squash Association depending on the number of entries. Knock-Out system may be used if draw size is too big.
- Matches Guaranteed: Players are guaranteed a minimum of 2 matches.
- Match Timing: Players are expected to play 2 matches a day. Check-in 30 minutes before scheduled match time. Matches will be played on a follow-on basis; postponement will not be entertained.

X. Tournament & Related Info

- Code of Conduct: All competitors agree to abide by the Macau Squash Association Code of Conduct and the WSF Junior Guidelines by entering the tournament.
- Official Ball: Dunlop Revelation Pro XX (double yellow dot)
- **Protective Eye Wear**: Mandatory for all junior players under 19, manufactured to an appropriate national standard and always worn properly over the eyes during competition play.
- **Marking/Refereeing**: All players must be prepared to assist with marking and/or refereeing matches after their own matches.
- Practice Courts: Available only on 27th August; reserve by emailing macaujropen@gmail.com.
