In the last six months (April-September 2023), all the things now at normal after the COVID-19 pandemic. It is good that we are back to almost normal now with the squash activities. We had Asian Games in Hangzhou China, Asian Individual Championships in Hong Kong, China, & Asian Junior Individual in Dalian, China. All events were very successfully held.

Last 6 months we had a few online focal point meetings & we also conducted meetings with WSO regarding concerns & lack of transparency/fairness for the Asian Referees appointments in PSA events from July-December 2023. We addressed these issues with WSO, and they insured to consider ASF concerns in the future referee's appointments.

During the last six months (April-September) we had a total number of 73 clinics conducted in China, Hong Kong China, India, Indonesia, Korea, Malaysia, Phillipines, Singapore, Thailand, & Pakistan. A number of 1214 participants attended the clinics. Referees clinics were conducted by Mohd Abdullah Arrffan (Singapore), Leslie Ponnampalam (Malaysia), Amos Yuen (Hong Kong, China), Anthony So (Hong Kong, China), Kim Chang Woo (Korea), Srikanth Seshadri (India), Mike Collins (South Africa), Roy Gingell (Wales) & Tahir Jamil Khanzada (Pakistan)

Assessment exercises were conducted in 6 events with 147 assessments in total, 22nd Asian Individual, Hong Kong China (14), Hong Kong Junior Open 2023 (14), Asian Junior Individuals Championships, China 2023 (21), 2nd CNS All Pakistan Squash Championship, Karachi (12), Indonesia PRE National Games PRA PON 2023, Jakarta (16), Asian Games 2023, China (70).

I would like to thank all the clinics/courses instructors and assessors in Asia and especially Mike Collins from South Africa & Roy Gingell from Wales to be a part of Hangzhou Asian Games 2023 and shared their experience and support during the games.

We look forward to and hope that more MNF's will conduct many championships in the Asia region to boost the squash activities during in the coming years.
